Scope and topic:

Full texts of all the presentations **oral and posters** will be included in the Proceedings CD of the workshop. Workshops proceedings **are published regularly and have a unique ISBN number**. The proceedings of the previous workshop can be downloaded from the SIG site. The authors should submit their paper until the 15th of June in order to be published in the Workshop Proceedings.
